Africa: The History of the Continent

Course Description:

Recently, the continent of Africa has become the center of rapidly growing interest among many Americans and people around the world. This course explores the unique history of the world's second largest continent, from ancient times to independence. It introduces students to Africa's history, its people, its places, and its political past. It traces the rise and fall of great empires, and it explores ancient civilization, slavery, European colonial rule, nationalism, and the struggle for freedom. It also addresses the historical contributions of nationalist leaders like Jomo Kenyatta, Julius Nyerere, Kwame Nkrumah, Sedar Senghor, Ahmed Ben Bella, Nelson Mandela, Samora Michelle and Patrice Lumumba. This course is a

fourteen-week voyage of discovery. Students will do selected readings, view documentary films, listen to guest speakers, and engage in group discussions.

Schedule

This class meets 14 Saturday's from 12:15-3:30PM, with the first half of the course being held at Truman Campus (9/5, 9/12, 9/19, 9/26, 10/3, 10/10, 10/17) and the second half at DePaul's Loop Campus (10/24, 10/31, 11/7, 11/14, 11/21, 11/28, 12/5).

Instructors

This course is team taught by DePaul University instructor Anghesom Atsbaha and Truman College instructor Glen Miller.
