Course Description

Today, world politics is making an unpredictable turn and undergoing an historical transition. International relations in the 21st century are more complex and facing more pressing global challenges than the previous century. While the Western nations have enjoyed unparalleled prosperity in recent years, developing nations, mired in debt, burdened in poverty, riddled with diseases ranging from malaria to AIDS, plagued by wars and genocide, are struggling to overcome crisis.

This course will examine the role of nation-states, international organizations like the United Nations, international law, international crimes court, treaties, and root causes and functions of war and peace in the making of foreign policies that have shaped and reshaped the relationships among nations. We will also focus on ethics in the context of a number of issues and practices in international relations ranging from global inequality, the promotion of human rights, foreign aid, immigration/forced deportation, humanitarian intervention, to terrorism, genocide, war crimes, and the use of torture.

Schedule

This class meets Tuesday's 6:00-9:05PM (14 sessions) with the first half of the course being held at Truman College Campus (9/1, 9/8 9/15, 9/22, 9/29, 10/6, 10/13) and the second half will be held at the DePaul's Loop Campus (10/20, 10/27, 11/3, 11/10, 11/17, 11/24, 12/1).
